GUIDE FOR PARENTS

This is an exciting time in your child's life! They're starting to ask questions about their faith. They're wondering about God and His love for them. They may be asking a lot of questions about Jesus - some that you may struggle with yourself or some that may not have a simple answer. But that's ok. This is the beginning of a life-long conversation about faith. That's why our guide begins with John 3:16, which lays the foundation for God's plan of salvation.

Over the next few pages, we'll break the verse down, phrase by phrase, with some questions to help you start a conversation with your kids. Here are some things to keep in mind:

2. If you have never trusted Jesus as your Savior, or you are not sure if you have, now is the perfect time! Why not make the important decision alongside your child?

- It's not about being good enough.
- We are not saved by praying a prayer, we are saved by putting our faith in Jesus as our Savior.
- Prayer is simply a way of expressing our trust in Jesus for all He has done on our behalf. There is no right prayer, so don't be worried about using the right words. Just focus on the heart behind the prayer.

So, what are you waiting for? It's time to take the first step across the Starting Line of faith and confess your belief in Jesus!



GOD'S PLAN FOR SALVATION

Parent Read:

GOD LOVED

God loved you before you were even born. He created you in His image, and He loves you right now. But there is something that separates us from Him, something that keeps us from being with Him forever.

It's called sin. Sin is anything that we think, say or do that goes against what God would want us to think, say, or do. It keeps us from living out the story that God wants for us. On our own, we can't do anything about this. We need God to step in and help. Because God loves us, He made a way for all of us to live with Him forever.

Ask Your Child:

1. What is sin?

2. What are some examples of how you have sinned?

Tip: You may need to help them identify some examples, such as lying, disobeying, stealing, and even selfish thoughts... all which also apply to adults.

3. What is the problem with sin?

Sin separates us from God forever. Additional reference:

For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Parent Read: GOD GAVE US JESUS

God gave the most important, valuable, and perfect thing He had for us. He knew that our sin would keep us from being a part of His family. We were separated from God and we couldn't come back to Him on our own.

But because God loves us, He gave His son to fix that relationship. Jesus gave up His life on the cross to pay for our sin. Three days later, Jesus rose from the dead! His resurrection defeated death and makes a relationship with God possible again. Jesus came to make a way for us to be in God's story.

Ask Your Child:

1. What did God give us?

Jesus, to save us from our sin.

2. Why did God give this gift?

Because He loves us and wants to mend our relationship with Him.

3. What did Jesus do for us?

He paid the price for our sins.

But here is how God has shown His love for us. While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Parent Read:

WE RECEIVE ETERNITY WITH JESUS

Jesus Gave: Jesus gave us the gift of salvation and the ability to spend eternity with Jesus. God says you can open His gift by believing in Jesus and asking Him to forgive you.

John 3:16 tells us that we receive eternal life when you believe in Jesus and trust Him to save you, you begin a new relationship with God that starts right away and goes on forever. Someday we will get to spend forever and ever with God in a place that He made perfect - Heaven.

WE BELIEVE IN JESUS

Believing simply means to trust. It's a lot like sitting in a chair. When you sit on a chair, you put all your weight on it. You trust that it will hold you up. That's what it's like to believe in or to trusts in this gift. To open the gift that God gave you, you trust in Jesus with your whole life and rest in the fact that He died and rose again for you.

Ask Your Child:

1. How do we trust in God?

We believe that He won't fail us, and that what he says is true.

2. How do you know God loves you?

He sent Jesus to die for us.

Here is what love is. It is not that we loved God. It is that He loved us and sent His Son to give His life to pay for our sins.

Ask Your Child: Are you ready to accept Jesus as your savior?

You can use the following prayer with your child as you lead them to trust Jesus. There's nothing magical about this prayer; it's simply a scriptural guideline to help you get started!

Jesus replied, "Let it be this way for now. It is right for us to do this. It carries out God's holy plan." Then John agreed. As soon as Jesus was baptized, he came up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened. Jesus saw the Spirit of God coming down on him like a dove. A voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, and I love him. I am very pleased with him."

THINK OF IT THIS WAY...

- The water is a symbol (or picture) of what happens when we are born again.
- Going under the water is a symbol (or picture) showing our old life being washed away.
- Coming up out of the water is a symbol (or picture) showing we are starting a new life with Jesus.



WHAT IF I WAS BAPTIZED AS A BABY?

We believe it is important for people who follow Jesus to get baptized **AFTER** they choose to believe in Jesus. We call that *Believer's Baptism*.

If you were baptized as a baby, and since then have personally accepted Jesus into your life, you can be baptized now to show everyone that you've chosen Jesus!

WHAT HAPPENS ON MY BAPTISM DAY?

- Come to church with your family and friends.
- Wear comfy clothes that are okay to get wet.
- You'll get a new t-shirt to celebrate this special moment!
- When it's time for you to be baptized, you'll get in the water, and the person baptizing you will ask you about your relationship with Jesus and why you want to be baptized.

- Then, they'll ask you to put one hand on your nose and the other on your wrist.
- Next, the person baptizing you will follow Jesus' command in Matthew 28:19, which reads, "So you must go and make disciples of all nations. Baptize them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit."
- You'll be baptized in God's name with these words: "I baptize you in the Name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit," and they will dip you under the water and bring you back up.

That's all there is to it!
